- Camp Kesem (\$500)
 - Camp Kesem is a non-profit organization that provides free summer camps for children who have been affected by a parent's cancer
 - Total budget of \$105,474
- 3rd Annual Campus Cleanup (\$200)
 - The Campus Cleanup is a project created by the Zero Waste Team to promote a culture of sustainability, to provide education about waste and to motivate students to take environmental responsibility.
 - The money will go toward t-shirts and breakfast for the event
 - Total budget of \$2,000
- Tabletop Games Association (\$244.62)
 - The Tabletop Games Association works to provide a supportive and approachable venue for Crown and other UCSC students to play tabletop games.
 - The money goes to replacing failing equipment and buying new games
