 - 2 components to the fee
 - 59% - Intercollegiate teams
 - \$2.3 mil budget -- students would pay \$1.5 mil, chancellor would contribute \$500k, and the rest would be through large-scale fundraising
 - Rest of the fee will go towards an FFE (Fund functioning as an endowment), which will provide financial assistance to students in need for activities related to wellness and fitness
 - New budget and business model is much more sustainable and conservative
