### **Presentations**

- Calpirg
  - Funded by students to protect public interests: different causes per year
    - Stop import of Amazon Crude Oil into California
      - California
      - California: leading force of expansion of Amazon crude oil
      - End goal: statewide ban of Amazon Crude Oil from California
        - Trying to pass resolutions (city council does not support the import of Amazon crude oil) in different cities
      - Wants endorsement from Crown Student Senate (“a glorified petition from a student body”)

## Funding Requests (\$7003)

- Global Game Jam (\$150)
  - Total cost: \$1970
    - Goes toward food+drinks, building fees, materials, etc.
  - A world-wide event where students come together to make a game in just 24 hours
    - Takes place globally so create ties between participants and larger game development community around the world
    - Encourages people to be inclusive, creative, and to come together to express themselves through games
  - January 26-28th 5pm-5pm at the DARC building
  - 150 students expected to participate
  - Free to participate!
- UCSC Taekwondo Club (\$100)
  - Recreational club that teaches students martial arts as self defense/learning experience
    - Sparring practices, demo team, perform for college nights/other events
    - No team dues and do not compete in collegiate circuits right now
    - \$6 fee - goes towards OPERS fees (club does not get any of it)
    - Funding request: save money for new equipment
    - Around 20 people attend each meeting
- Red Wheelbarrow (\$400)
  - Annually published anthology- visual art, poetry, fiction, nonfiction, and critical works of fellow UCSC students
  - Books are free for all students!
  - Distributed during spring quarter
    - Distributed in cafes, bookstore, lounges, etc.
  - Accepting submissions until January (soft deadline) - until February!
  - Outreach for submitting art: flyers, social media, creative writing classes/events, art department, and word of mouth
  - Printing costs: \$4596.24 + \$390.68 tax
- CPR First Aid Awareness Workout (\$200)

- Saturday, November 18th 10-2 pm | UCSC Police Department
  - Get CPR certified at a reduced cost
    - Goal: get everyone certified for free
    - If not fully funded, will try to subsidize as much funds as possible
- Outreach to whole campus
  - Social media, bus stop flyers, and college flyers
- Total cost: \$1500
  - SUA: \$500
  - All colleges: \$200 each
  - Police department are providing the instructor fee, facility, and food
  - \$35-40 per person for the certification fee
- If Crown funds: Crown recognition/shout out
